

Jewish Book Council is excited to announce **JBC READ ON: A Jewish Author Speakers' Bureau**. This program is a speakers' bureau for those authors who have previously participated with JBC Network, Jewish Book Council's author touring program, over the last 20 years. JBC connects authors, who otherwise may not have had the opportunity to speak about their book after being eligible for JBC Network.

How does JBC READ ON work?

- Choose from a vast list of authors who have previously participated with JBC Network. These authors are available for keynote events, book club programs, meetings, and book tours. JBC staff will work to provide the best speaker for the designated program.

How much do speakers cost?

- Speakers' fees vary author to author. We will find an author that will fit your budget and topics that fit your needs. Our speakers' fees range from \$1,000 to more than \$8,000. The JBC fee is contained in the speaker's honorarium.
- If requested speaker is asked to participate in additional events while at your location, such as a dinner or reception, it must be determined prior to completing the contract.
- Author's fees do not include expenses. The host site is responsible for airfare, ground transportation, and accommodations at first rate hotel, meals, and incidental expenses.
- Members of JBC Network will receive a discounted rate on booked authors.
- Fees include a 35-45 minute presentation followed by a Q & A and book signing. Fees may change based on the type of program requested.
- Sites must host a book sale and signing.
