

Jewish Book Council is excited to announce a new endeavor called **JBC READ ON: A Jewish Author Speakers' Bureau**. This program is a speakers' bureau for those authors who have previously participated with JBC Network, Jewish Book Council's author touring program, over the last 20 years. JBC connects authors, who otherwise may not have had the opportunity to speak about their book after being eligible for JBC Network.

Who is eligible?

- Any author who has previously registered with JBC Network and whose book has a copyright date past the current JBC Meet the Author tour eligibility date.
- Books must still be in print.
- Books must be published in English and distributed in the United States.
- Translations to English are accepted.

Will I receive an honorarium to speak?

- Authors will receive an honorarium for speaking. A speaker's fee will be arranged based on the program.
- All travel expenses will be paid by the host site.
- Payment will be issued through Jewish Book Council.

What are the benefits of participation?

- Scheduling and arrangements will be coordinated by Jewish Book Council.
- List distributed to all JBC Network members.
- Author and book listing in the **JBC READ ON** section of jewishbookcouncil.org.
- Exposure of **JBC READ ON** through JBC's digital channels throughout the year.
- Book sale and signing at each site event.
